


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Sadbhavana Diwas

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CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA)

1) Joining The Dots (Nursery/LKG/UKG)

Joining the dots activity is specially designed to increase hand and eye coordination. Through this activity the little toddlers build their fine motor skills.



2) Runway Models (Fancy Dress) - I & II Std

Runway models Modelling is an effective instructional strategy in that it allows students to observe and imitate. So the Activity specially designed to enhance the quality of imitation of particular behaviour that increased the learning amongst the students.





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3) Hand Magic (Clay Modeling) - III & IV Std

Modelling activity is specially designed to promote creativity amongst the students. It is especially beneficial for students because it helps to promote self-confidence, encourages self-expression and develops problem solving skills



4) Pot Art (Pot Making) - V & VI Std

Pottery painting is a calming and relaxing activity that allows students to learn that quite patient activity can be as awarding as running around on the playground.
